Thanks be the glory for *Missionary Steve Martinez of the Lighthouse Christian Serviceman Center in Dale City, Virginia* (June 2006) in sharing the gospel with our U.S. Military. Praise the Lord for answering prayers, this ministry was blessed with a tremendous new location and facility for the Servicemen Center. They have 2 beautiful acres of land, approximately 6,000 sq. ft of living space and ample parking. It is a real "retreat" type of setting. What God has done is amazing! All Glory to God – Praise His Holy Name! Continued prayer for a harvest of souls here among our military as we continue in our work here at the "Cross Roads" of the Marine Corps where new souls are always coming and going – thousands have already received the Gospel as they have passed through here over the past 4 years, many have trusted Christ as their Savior and we look forward to 2006 being a year of bountiful harvest among our military.

All the Glory to God! *Colonial Press, Pastor Leake (July 2006)* is reaching the little children. Colonial sent 26,000 Gospel coloring books in the French Creole language to Haiti where they shared the greatest news of hope to a

generation whose future looks so bleak; Colonial has provided the Gospel coloring book in several languages and more translations are being prepared; continued request for the booklet "Born of God" both in English and Spanish are being made and one church has requested 1200 Spanish copies for an upcoming mission trip to Colombia, South America; another church has requested the same amount in English for a summer evangelistic campaign in their area; Colonial is also in the process of printing and assembling 160,000 pastoral training materials to be used in Africa to teach and train men to become pastors and leaders in churches planted in the many locations. The process is slow but still moving as we wait for the building permit for the new print shop, prayfully we will be in the shop by the end of the year. Your prayers in this area are greatly appreciated – thank you for your prayers and support, you have a part in this great mission effort that will have eternal impact!

Missionary Christi and Scott Bailes (June 2006) gave praises for the over 20 leaders elected from their ministry to serve in their respective areas of ministry. This is clearly the beginning of a concentrated focus and commitment to build up the local body and a preparation for new outreach and growth. We have seen various children, along with 2 new families come to faith in Christ since March and 2 single brothers in Christ who moved from Mexico City to be part of the church. Please pray for our land/building fund The "Roca Eterna" Project. The church was renting 2 lots back to back for a year and half, one lot is empty and other has a warehouse building (land 4,500 sq. ft./building 6,500 sq. ft.). We were blessed to have been offered by the owner the opportunity to buy the property for \$200,000 (USD) or 2.2 million pesos. We accepted the offer with help for financing provided by two business people in our congregation who signed the contract. We were also extremely blessed with the generous offering of about one quarter of the asking price for the down payment from the same people. There is much work to be done and we ask for your prayers and thank you for your support. Lastly, we give praises for prayer to find a house to rent, this is officially house #11 (the girl's favorite house yet) since beginning our family almost 15 years ago. The girls are working hard to finish their school work and longing for summer vacation.

Missionary Bill & Sallie DeWeese (May 2006) gave praises for the answer prayer for new teachers, they have 9 new teachers going to China with at least 20 students they are in contact with through their recruiting efforts at the mission conference in Northland Baptist Bible College in Wisconsin and Ambassador Baptist College. Praises for an increase in 1 individual who started monthly support and 3 churches that has increased their monthly support.

Missionary Fredrick, Antoinette Kearney (June 2006) gave praises for safe travel to California and Texas; donations of useful supplies have been plentiful (300 sewing machines, Hymnals, CDs, KJV Bibles, soccer and basketballs, and musical instruments; Frederick was able to attend a Medical Intensive Program training in April that covered many problems he might encounter in a village with no doctor. They report that they have reached about 98% support.
